xen-Web is an easy-to-use Internet Browser-based system allowing access to the Intellectual Property information stored in a Xensis xen-IP database, such as information for...

- Patent, Trade Mark, Design & Domain applications
- Agreements with third-parties, such as technology licensed in or out
- Task lists/diary
- Proposals/inventions
- Electronic document store
- Contact information (Patent/TM Offices, Agents, External Companies, etc.)

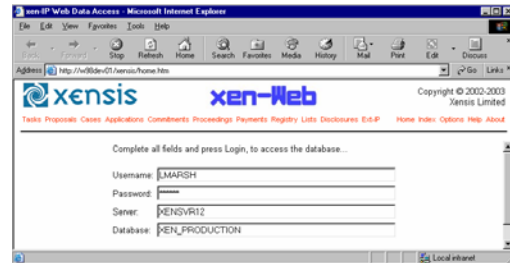
xen-Web is typically used where the IP department wants to give restricted access to people such as...

- Users outside the IP department (eg. inventors, clients, agents, annuity agencies, etc.)
- Managers who only want occasional access to view information
- Off-site users who need access to IP information from any location in the world

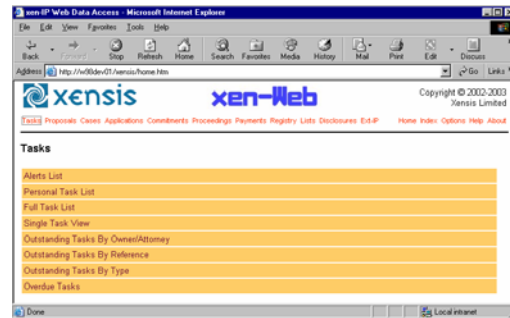
The benefits of using xen-Web are:

- No additional software to install, uses standard Internet Browsers
- Electronic access to the on-line master database
- Users can access documents in the document store
- Reduced licence costs
- Secure access via your Intranet, Virtual Private Network or Secure Internet Server

xen-Web provides secure access to your data, requiring a username and password to log on...



Each menu option provides a selection of different Data Views from which you can choose...



After selecting a Data View you can specify one or more selection criteria, plus the sort order, so that the data you will see will be exactly what you want. For example, you could view data for...

- Tasks due in the next 14 days
- US Applications that are Granted
- All EPO Applications for a family

You can “drill down” from many fields to see more details, this could be to show the full details for an application, the details for a Patent Office or associated data such as tasks, costs or documents.

Options can be set to hide empty fields, restrict the number of records returned and to make xen-Web more specific to Patents or Trade Marks depending on the data you most frequently access.

Features

- Secure password-protected access
- Around 60 different Data Views (Xensis can create custom Data Views for a fee)
- User-defined selection criteria
- Wildcard characters can be used for partial data matches
- Date ranges can be specified
- Dropdown selection lists can be used where appropriate, for example when selecting countries or Attorney names
- User-defined record sorting from dropdown lists
- Unlimited “drill down” to see more details
- Option to hide empty fields, making the data display more concise
- Option to hide Patent or Trade Mark specific fields if not required
- Option to limit the number of records returned to prevent retrieving the entire database !!

- Data available can be restricted on an individual user basis (eg. Inventors can only see application data)
- Individual users can be restricted to only see data for selected businesses to keep business data private
- Comprehensive help system
- Data access includes...
 - Case/Dockets
 - Applications (Priority, Substantive, SPCs, etc.)
 - Task lists/Diary
 - Alerts for critical data situations
 - Commitments/Agreements with third parties (licensing in/out, etc.)
 - Proceedings/Oppositions
 - Proposals/Inventions
 - Patent/Trade Mark Office data
 - Agent payment information
 - Annuity Agency information
 - Payments information
 - Annuity payment information
 - Documents in the electronic document store
